Eminent Political Scientist and Thinker

Passed away 31.01.2016

Office-bearers of Punjabi Sahit Akademi paid last respects to the mortal remains of prominent thinker Prof Randhir Singh, who passed away 31.01.2016 last week at the age of 94 in Delhi.

The office-bearers led by president Dr Sukhdev Singh Sirsa along with members of Punjabi Lekhak Sabha paid floral tributes to Dr Singh and welcomed Prof Randhir Singh's daughters — **Seema Leen** and (SPA Professor) **Priya Leen**, and playwright Gursharan Bhaji's daughters among others, who stopped over at the Punjabi Sahit Akademi on their way to Hussainiwala village from Chandigarh.

Dr Sirsa said Dr Randhir Singh was a **prominent thinker** and with his demise a void had been created in the world of thinkers. But his writings would continue to inspire and enlighten the coming generations, he said.

General Secretary of Punjabi Sahit Akademi said Prof Randhir Singh was not only an eminent political scientist, but also had a deep understanding of issues related to Punjab.

He also made a very significant contribution as Dean / Head and longtime professor at the University of Delhi 1970s – 1990s .
