The Padma Bhushan, India’s third-highest civilian award, has been presented to Colorado law Professor Ved Prakash Nanda. The John Evans Distinguished University Professor and Thompson G. Marsh Professor of Law at the University of Denver, has taught at the University since 1965. He is among 85 individuals selected for Padma awards 2018.

Alumnus Ved is also Founding Director and Director Emeritus International Legal Studies Program and Director *Ved Nanda Center for International and Comparative Law* at Denver University USA.

He is Honorary President and past President World Jurist Association; counselor and former honorary Vice President American Society of International Law; and Member Advisory Council United States Institute of Human Rights.

He has authored / co-authored 22 books in various fields of international law and over 180 chapters and major law review articles. Besides, Ved is Distinguished Visiting Professor and scholar at a number of universities in the United States and abroad.

Among his several accolades is the Gandhi - King Ikeda Award for Community Peace Building.
