NEW DELHI: Indian Ambassador to Russia Pankaj Saran has been appointed Deputy National Security Adviser, a Government order said on Tuesday 29.05.2018:

"The Appointments Committee of the Cabinet ACC has approved the appointment of Pankaj Saran IFS 1982 batch as deputy NSA for a period of two years".

The appointment is on a deputation basis till he retires in November 2018 and on a re-employment on contract for the remainder of the two- year period or until further orders, whichever is earlier, said the release.
