

The Vasant Vihar resident developed his vocal skills under the tutelage of maestros like Pandit Ravi Shankar, Ustad Ali Akbar Khan and Annapurna Devi (daughter of legendary Baba Allaudin Khan and former wife of Pandit Ravi Shankar). And his majestic voice and perseverance helped him to bag opportunities to perform across the world. So far he has performed at over 400 concerts. However, it hasn't come easy and even today the disciplinary man starts the day early. The slot between 5am and 8am is reserved for riyaaz. The soonto-be-80 artiste claims, "Music is cocktail for me. I get drunk on it."

His upcoming release is a compilation of his music recordings. "The 12 CDs have recordings of my concerts from all over the world in the last four decades. There are more than 25 ragas in these CDs (all evening and late night ragas), based on love between Radha and Krishna," says Vinay.

The unique album of Vinay's 60 – year – creative **raga** journey was released 19.12.2015 at a gala event attended by, among others, Pt Hariprasad Chaurasia, Ustad Aashish Khan and his "guru niece" Anoushka Shankar.
