

Ambassador Aftab Seth is the Chairman of India Global Link Co. Ltd, Sun and Sands Advisors Ltd. Global traveller and erudite scholar, he served as Ambassador to Japan, Micronesia, Vietnam ,Greece and in Beirut, with diplomatic stints in Cairo, Jakarta , Karachi and Hamburg .

Author of 3 books, including "How Much Weight Can an Elephant Lose?" 2002 which won the Mahatma Gandhi-Martin Luther King Daisaku Ikeda Award.

His days as a student in Tokyo in the early sixties bring alive the flavour of Japan before the 1964 Olympics, the first big coming - out party for Japan in the 20th century.

The mystique associated with the Chrysanthemum Throne, the oldest monarchy is seen by an ambassador who knows the Japanese language, the people and many members of the Imperial Family.

Beyond the world of diplomacy, the author gives an account of the years spent in Japan as a university professor. The last decade of the author's connections with Japan describe attempts to link academic institutions across many continents, the work of an NGO he founded and the many educational institutions with which the author is connected.

His book is a credible and delightful panoramic view of half a century of India's relations with Japan.
