

## Vice Chancellor Prof. Dinesh Singh to be conferred Honorary Doctorate by The University of Edinburgh



Vice Chancellor Prof. Dinesh Singh will be conferred an honorary doctorate by the University of Edinburgh at a special ceremony this summer. Principal and *Vice-Chancellor Professor Sir Timothy O'Shea* gave this information at a meeting in Delhi on 23 February 2014 during his academic tour of universities in India.
