A BOOK ROLE FOR SONAM based on Anuja's book



Actor Sonam Kapoor will be seen playing the lead in father-actor Anil Kapoor's yet-untitled film, based on **author Anuja Chauhan's** book, Battle For Bittora

Last year, actor Sonam Kapoor had an on-screen brush with politics when she played a political activist in the film, Raanjhanaa. Since Sonam's first film, Saawariya (2007), was loosely based on Fyodor Dostoevsky's *White Nights*, and *Aisha* (2010) was a modern interpretation of Jane Austen's Emma, this will be her third film based on a book.
