US President Barack Obama on Thursday nominated MasterCard's Indian American (DU alumnus) **CEO Ajay Banga** to a newly announced commission on enhancing national cybersecurity.

This Commission was set up in February to “make detailed recommendations to strengthen cybersecurity in both the public and private sectors while protecting privacy, ensuring public safety and economic and national security”, according to its mission statement.

An alumnus of Delhi's **St Stephen's College**, he was with Citigroup in various capacities from 1996 to 2009 with his last assignment there being CEO of the group's Asia Pacific unit.

He is also co-chair of the American India Foundation.
