Justice Rajiv Sahai Endlaw orders re-sealing of The Connaught, CP 20.05.2016

Four days after New Delhi Municipal Council's estate officer M M Khan was shot dead, the Delhi High

Court on Friday (20.05.2016) ordered the re-sealing of The Connaught hotel owned by Prominent

Hotels Ltd. The hotel's lease had been terminated in 1995, and after a lengthy court battle, it was

sealed in February last year after the HC cleared the decks for eviction and recovery proceedings.

Khan was in charge of that.

Justice Rajiv Sahai Endlaw (BA His Hons 1979 and LLB 1983) in his order declined to extend the

earlier permission given to de-seal the hotel premises and made it clear that the relief was only meant

to be temporary in nature.

The court told NDMC it wouldn't stand in the way of its sealing and recovery proceedings, and that

the civic agency doesn't need permission for resealing.

...Justice Endlaw pointed out that the permission was to facilitate removal of belongings of staffers

and guests. The Connaught is a four - star luxury hotel near Shivaji Stadium off Connaught Place

(CP).
